

# Poster and Photography Exhibit Information

The categories for entries are:

1. Posters
2. Forensic Photographs
3. Artistic Photographs

The Online Exhibit Contest Form must be completed online by Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 11:59pm to be accepted as a valid entry. Please fill out the form and email it to [csams001@so.cccounty.us](mailto:csams001@so.cccounty.us). Entries submitted at the Seminar will be welcome, but the eligibility of late entries will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. In addition to submitting the entry form, the online form must be printed and attached to the back of the Poster/Photograph submission and submitted to the Registration Room at the Seminar on Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>.

## Poster Exhibits:

The poster exhibits must be presented on a trifold poster board. Individual or group posters are accepted.

\*\*\*Do not forget to attach a copy of the Online Exhibit Form to the back side of the poster.

- Forensic Practitioners can submit a poster on a new technique, research in the field, or a case review.
- Student(s) can submit a poster on a topic within any of the forensic disciplines, history, new research, etc.

## Photography Exhibits:

There are two categories for the photography exhibits: Forensic and Artistic. Each participant may submit a single photograph for each category, but participants are only eligible to win a prize in one category. The photograph can be in color or in black and white. The photograph must be mounted on a foam board, not in a frame. The size of the photograph must be at least 8.5" x 11". Stands and easels will be provided.
